All IB students are required to take six subjects; one from each of the groups 1 – 5 below, and as the sixth subject, you may choose Visual Arts or another subject from groups 2, 3 or 4. *The IB recommends 3 Higher Level and 3 Standard Level courses*. (It is possible to have 4 HL and 2 SL subjects.)

At the start of the school year you can discuss your choices individually with the IB Coordinator who will be able to advise you about good combinations. <u>So don't worry about making a final decision at this stage.</u>

- The school reserves the right to cancel a subject if there is insufficient student interest to make up a group.
- Students may choose two Language A subjects instead of a Language A and a Language B subject. The same language cannot be chosen from both group 1 and 2 (For example, you cannot choose both Norwegian A and Norwegian B.)
- All subjects are not offered at both HL and SL. See boxes below for availability
- These subject combinations are not possible due to conflicts in the school timetable, so students cannot choose both:
  - History and Psychology
  - Chemistry and Visual Arts
  - o Physics and Biology

- For an application to be considered, the applicant must have a registered address in Viken County .Families moving to Norway during the spring 2021 must present a registered address in Viken County before 1 June 2023. If you are applying from outside of Norway or Viken fylkeskommune, you must contact Viken inntakskontoret (admissions office) before 1 March 2023 if possible: +47 22055022 or email: inntak@viken.no as well as submitting this completed application form to the school.
- All applicants for the IB programme must also be registered at <a href="www.vigo.no">www.vigo.no</a> (videregående opplæring) <a href="mailto:before">before</a> the application deadline of 1 March 2021. (This only applies to applicants with permanent address in Norway; all others must contact the Viken admissions office: <a href="mailto:inntak@viken.no">inntak@viken.no</a>).

- Priority for acceptance is given to students who have completed Norwegian Vg1 or the equivalent.
