- All applicants for the IB programme must also be registered at <u>www.vigo.no</u> (videregående opplæring) <u>before</u> <u>the application deadline of 1 March 2021.</u> (This only applies to applicants with permanent address in Norway; all others must contact the Viken admissions office: <u>inntak@viken.no</u>).
- Viken fylkeskommune has determined a school fee of 6000 NOK per school year for all students in the IB programme.
- **Priority for acceptance** is given to students who have completed Norwegian Vg1 or the equivalent.
